

Athena Beatbox

Multimedia wireless speaker

Connecting your Athena Beatbox with Bluetooth

1. Switch the power button on the bottom to "ON".
2. Enable Bluetooth in the settings of your device.
3. Search for new Bluetooth devices around you.
4. Select "Athena" from the list of devices.
5. A short sound will confirm that your Athena Beatbox was successfully connected. You can also see the status led light will go from rapidly flashing blue, to a little slower green and blue flashing.

The next time you switch on your Athena Beatbox, it will connect automatically to your device.

You can only have the Athena Beatbox pairing to one device at a time.

Handsfree calls

When connected to a phone you can accept incoming calls by pushing the centre button (M).

Charging

Use the USB cable to charge the battery. Once the battery is fully charged (2.5h) the red light will go out. If the battery is total empty you have to wait 15 min before you can turn Athena on and play music.

Connecting with Aux or Micro SD Card

Put the 3.5mm aux cable in to your Athena and to your device and it will automatically connect to aux. The Status led light will turn green. For SD card just press the card into the sd card holder it will connect automatically. When you take out the cable or micro sd card the Athena Beatbox will automatically turn back to Bluetooth.
